

ASK YOUR CHILD: Write some of the things you see at the store.





LOVE ART? WANT TO BE AN ART DOCENT?






Great Readers always track their words by pointing to each word as they read.

READING FOCUS

<u>Reading:</u> We have been learning "HOW TO I FARN A WORD"



ASK YOUR CHILD: Teach me how to learn the word "the".

MATH FOCUS

<u>Math</u>: We are continuously learning how to write numbers I-8 carefully and accurately. Playing "Hide and Seek" with dots on a 5-frame has been so much fun!

Ask your child: What are the hidden numbers in the number 8.? Practice with your child saying..."__ and ___ make 8!" This will prepare them for number sentences.
